How to avoid an **ONLINE PURCHASE OR RENTAL SCAM**

- Meet the landlord, speak to current tenants, and see the property in person.
- Refuse to pay any money before seeing the property or product. Common excuses for the seller refusing to meet may be; out of town or dealing with an emergency.
- Beware of “deals” that are too good to be true.
